Election Notice:

Sub: Election of the Eight Representative of Managements of Affiliated/ Conducted / Autonomous Colleges and Recognized Institutions to the Senate under Section 25(2) (m) and to the Academic Council of Two Representative of Management under Section 29(2) (n) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.

Attention of the Principals of all the Affiliated/Conducted/Autonomous Colleges and Recognized Institutions is invited to this Office Circular/Notification No./ Senate/25(2)(m)/A.C.29(2)(n)/41-C of 2010 dated 15th July, 2010 and they are hereby informed that under Statute 355(a) read with Section 115(2)(xii) of Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 the Vice-Chancellor has fixed 26th October, 2010 as the date of election to elect Eight Representatives of the Managements to the Senate of whom two shall be women and at least one shall be a person belonging to the SC/ST/DTNT/OBC by rotation and Two Representative of Management to the Academic Council for a term of five years commencing from 1st September, 2010. The election shall be held by post in accordance with the procedure laid down under Statutes 375 to 377.

They are hereby further informed that at the last election held in 2005, one person belonging to the ST category represented on the Senate and therefore as per the rotation at this election a person belonging to the DTNT category shall be represented on the Senate. In case the Person from DTNT category is not available, the Person from OBC category shall be considered as per the rule of rotation.

2. An electoral roll has been prepared and published on 14th September, 2010. As per circular No.EL/ (Senate-25(2) (m)/A.C.-29(2) (n)/41-D of 2010 dated 14th September, 2010, the Persons whose names have been included in the electoral roll of the Representative of Management of the Affiliated/ Conducted/ Autonomous Colleges and Recognized Institutions shall be entitled to exercise their franchise at the said election but they are entitled to contest the election subject to their fulfillment of eligibility conditions laid down under Section 24 (A) of the Maharashtra University Act 1994. (Govt. order No. USG.2009/ (85/09)/UNI-4 dt. 14th September, 2009.) Copies of the electoral roll are made available at the cost of Rs. 25/- each at the following places:-

3. Statute 361, which is quoted below, empowers the Vice-Chancellor to correct the electoral roll which has been published by the University on 14th September, 2010:-

“Statute 361:- The Vice-Chancellor shall have the authority to correct the rolls, if any omission or wrong entries be brought to his notice at least 15 clear days before the date of election. The Vice-Chancellor’s decision in the matter shall be final”.

4. Nomination papers in the prescribed form must be filled up in all respect.

5. The prescribed forms of nomination papers will be supplied to any elector on request in the office of the Registrar and Returning officer i.e. Election Section, Room No. 110, First Floor, University of Mumbai Fort, Mumbai- 400 032. The nomination papers will also be made available in the Office of the Assistant Registrar, Sub-Centre Ratanagiri, University of Mumbai, P-61, M.I.D.C., Mirjole, Ratnagiri – 415 639.

6. The Nomination papers completed in all respects must reach the Registrar and Returning Officer, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032; not later than 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, 10th October, 2010. No person shall be nominated as a candidate for election unless he/she signifies his/her consent on the nomination paper. It shall not be open to the elector to propose or second the candidature of more persons than the number of seats to be filled. A nomination paper which does not comply with all the requirements herein mentioned shall be invalid and it shall be rejected.

7. In accordance with the provisions of Statute 375, it shall be open to a candidate to withdraw from an election, provided that the candidate wishing to withdraw, sends to the Registrar and Returning Officer, an intimation of such withdrawal in writing signed by the candidate, so as to reach him within two days after the date and hour fixed as the last date and the hour for receipt of nominations. The nominations shall be scrutinized by the Registrar and Returning Officer or the committee appointed by the Vice-chancellor on Monday, 11th October, 2010 in the Phirozshash Mehta Management Council Hall, University Main Building, First Floor, North Wing, Fort, Mumbai- 400 032, at 11.30 a.m. The candidate or his/her agent, duly authorized by him/her in writing in that behalf shall be entitled to remain present at the time of scrutiny, provided that he/she must be a voter in that constituency.

8. In the event of there being a contest for the election, voting papers will be supplied to the electors at least ten clear days before the date of the election. Voting will be by post according to the system of proportional representation by means of a single transferable vote. Instructions regarding the method of casting the vote and attestation shall be enclosed along with the voting papers.
