Regulation 8633

Relating to Engineering

(Introduced with effect from the academic year 2013–2014)

AC 27/2/13 Item no 4.81

Conversion of marks to credit and grades for the students who have admitted to first year Engineering prior to and in Academic year 2011—2012 and will be admitted to second year Engineering in Academic year 2013-14 and thereafter.

R.8633 Conversion of Performance in marks to credits and grades for students who were admitted to the second year of the Degree Program/Course in an affiliated college:

- A. Who took admission to first year program/courses in and prior to the academic year 2011-2012
- B. Who completed their first year Degree program/course from colleges affiliated to other universities where credit system is not implemented.

I. Applicable to students who have passed FY Exam.: In case of Technology faculty, for Engineering Course

a) The performance at the Semester- I and Semester- II Examination can be taken each of 27 credits and can be converted into grade points as per the procedure mentioned in the manual of credit and grading system.

OR

b) The performance at the Semester- I and Semester-II Examination can be adopted and converted into credits and grades as per the procedure mentioned in the manual of credit and grading system.

II. Applicable to students who have ATKT in at least one subject:

- a) The student may be permitted to appear through the parent institute or can appear at the currently admitted institute for the subject's (Course) in which the student has failed.
- b) Once he passes the course's (Subject's), clause I (a) or b)) whichever is applicable can be applied. Also the students / learners whose Sem-I of First year Engineering, Pharmacy, MCA and Architecture is granted and due to some reason, Sem-II is not granted will be permitted to continue their study with Revised syllabus with Credit and Grading system introduced from A.Y. 2012-13, after their marks of semester I will be converted to credits and grades as given in clause I (a) or b)); whichever is applicable.
